Professional Acknowledgment for Continuing Education (P.A.C.E.) CE's

All laboratory professionals who are licensed or certified need CE. Some employers also require CE in addition to or in place of those requirements. It varies employer to employer and state to state, but basically anyone who works in a lab in some capacity needs CE for some reason. This would also include all Medical Laboratory Scientists, formerly Clinical Laboratory Scientists or Medical Technologists (known as MLSs, CLSs, or MTs); all Medical Laboratory Technicians, formerly Clinical Laboratory Technicians (known as MLTs or CLTs); and some Phlebotomy Technicians or PBTs. Typically, they need 12 contact hours per year to meet most requirements.

 - The process of approving the speaker's presentation and offering the attendee the CE credit and certificate is internal to our company
- P.A.C.E. CE credits are acceptable in all states and countries in the world except for Florida, USA.

- Speakers and their presentation are approved to offer CE credits by providing a presentation that is educational as it relates to science, and requires 2 learning objectives of their presentation (per 50 minutes of presentation)
- Following the CE approved presentation, an attendee will be required to fill out an evaluation of the presentation to receive their CE certificate. These certificates are processed and provided by LabRoots
- P.A.C.E. CE credits are available during the presentations enduring (On-Demand) period and expire after 2 years from the date of the live broadcast.
